Environmental Organizations' Joint
Response to December 17, 2019 Resolution
and Order.

RESOLUTION

On December 13, 2019, the Local Environmental Organizations filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Motion from Local Environmental Organizations to Compel AES Puerto Rico L.P. to Respond to Discovery Requests* ("Motion"). Through its Motion, the Local Environmental Organizations stated that, on November 4, 2019, they issued a First Request of Information ("ROI #1") to AES Puerto Rico, L.P. ("AES-PR"), which the latter had not responded within the timeframe provided.

On December 17, 2019, the Energy Bureau issued a Resolution and Order ("December 17 Order") through which it ordered AES-PR to serve its responses to the Local Environmental Organizations' ROI #1 on or before December 20, 2019.


On December 18, 2019, AES-PR and the Local Environmental Organizations filed a document titled *Joint Response to December 17, 2019 Resolution and Order* ("Joint Motion"). Through their Joint Motion, the parties requested the Energy Bureau to (i) withdraw the December 17 Order; and (ii) extend the time for AES-PR to respond to ROI #1 until January 10, 2020. Additionally, as part of the Joint Motion, the Local Environmental Organizations acknowledged that it did not serve ROI #1 to AES-PR, directly or through counsel.

On January 10, 2020, AES-PR served the Local Environmental Organizations a document titled *Response of AES Puerto Rico, L.P. to First Request of Information from Intervenor, Local Environmental Organizations, to Intervenor, AES Puerto Rico L.P.* ("AES-PR's Responses") through the means established by the Energy Bureau's instructions for the notification of discovery.¹

Based on the above, the Energy Bureau **TAKES NOTICE** of AES-PR's Responses and **DETERMINES** that the Joint Motion has been addressed by the parties.


