Organizations' Motion to Compel
Production of Documents Required by
Energy Bureau Order.

RESOLUTION


On February 20, 2020, the Local Environmental Organizations filed before the Energy Bureau of the Puerto Rico Public Service Regulatory Board ("Energy Bureau") a document titled *Motion from Local Environmental Organizations to Compel PREPA to Produce Aurora Modeling Files in Compliance with Puerto Rico Energy Bureau Order of January 29, 2020* ("Motion"). Through its Motion, the Local Environmental Organizations request the Energy Bureau to order the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority ("PREPA") to (i) within a term of five (5) days, to produce the Aurora modeling files in compliance with the January 29, 2020 Resolution and Order¹ in the instant case; and (ii) provide an explanation of PREPA's failure to produce the files by the due date.²


Upon review of the administrative file in the instant case, to this date, none of the Local Environmental Organizations representatives have signed a Non-Disclosure Agreement ("NDA"). As stated in the January 29 Order, a signed NDA is a prerequisite to access confidential information, as established in the August 31, 2016 Resolution in Case No. CEPR-MI-2016-0009 ("August 31, 2016 Resolution"). Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of the August 31, 2016 Resolution, in order for the Local Environmental Organizations to obtain access to information designated by the Energy Bureau as confidential in the instant case, the Local Environmental Organizations must submit a duly executed NDA to the Energy Bureau for its approval. Access will be granted pursuant the procedures established in the August 31, 2016 Resolution.


